

3rd ANNUAL SOUTH RIVER VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT BUCK CONTEST

Buck Contest Rules:

1. All contestants must pay \$25.00 to enter the South River Fire Department Big Buck Contest. A person will be considered entered when the entry fee is paid and name signed on sign-up sheet.
2. A contestant must have a valid Virginia hunting license and big game permit, and may be required to show proof of the license and big game permit. **Check card (no call in's) must be presented when an animal is brought in to be scored.** All animals entered in the contest must be harvested in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. Failure to abide by the rules and regulations of the VDGIIF will be grounds for disqualification from this years contest and possibly some or all future Big Buck Contests.
3. Deer may be taken during the 2011-2012 archery, muzzleloading or modern firearms seasons.
4. Up to 3 entries per person.
5. Last day to have buck scored will be January 7, 2012.
6. Deer must be killed by entrant.
7. In case of a tie, the tie breaker will be widest inside spread.
8. In case of a tie after the tiebreaker has already been considered, the second tiebreaker will be the longest tine.
9. If the main beams are moveable, the measurements will be made the narrowest point when the antlers are held in.
10. Any entry may be rescored if necessary.
11. Scoring will be done using a modified Virginia Deer Scoring System.
