

# RADIO NUMBERS STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINE

DATE APPROVED: APRIL 2011

## **I. Scope**

This standard establishes guidelines for the assignment of radio identifiers to apparatus and personnel.

## **II. General**

- A. A numbering system is intended to reduce confusion when apparatus from multiple jurisdictions are operating at the same incident.

## **III. Individual Radio Numbers**

- A. The radio numbers are assigned to all personnel when they are issued turn out gear.
- B. Line Officers will use their rank and company number as their identifier. (CHIEF 7)
- C. When operating on an Augusta County frequency, identify yourself as South River whomever.

Chief 7-2	2 <sup>nd</sup> Assistant Fire Chief – Jamie Wilmer
Captain 7	Captain – Pam Whorley
Lieutenant 7	Lieutenant – Kris Whitesell

## **IV. Apparatus Numbers**

- A. Apparatus are assigned an individual number to assist in apparatus tracking and designation. The additional identifier of South River **does** need to be used with Augusta County Emergency Communication Center.
